

9 to 5 Cast and Crew Bios

Submit your bio to Peter at peterfitzcamp@gmail.com with 9 TO 5 BIO in the subject line. Bios are due no later than Monday, March 2nd.

Please follow these guidelines:

- Bios should be between 60 and 100 words. Please count the words before submitting to make sure they fall in this range.
- The body should be written in the third person (she/he, her/his).
- Start with First Name Last Name followed by your role/crew position in parentheses:
 - For cast: Tony Gonzalez (Teveye)
 - For crew: Suzy Technical (Light Board Operator)
- Your bios are subject to editing for grammar, formatting, and content by Peter and Ms. Hutton. Peter will review any changes with you before the program goes to print.
- Remember that this is not a Facebook status or tweet; these are going to be read by more than 2,000 audience members and people often hold on to show programs as mementos. Please put some real thought into these and take them seriously. You can feel free to be creative, but don't get ridiculous. And remember – you are representing not only yourself, but Cheltenham Music Theatre and CHS.

Ideas for what to include in your bio:

- Your grade
- Shows you've appeared in or worked on before *9 to 5*.
 - Show titles are typed in italics, with the role you played in parentheses
 - i.e. *Fiddler on the Roof* (Teveye)
 - If you would like to note that you were an understudy, write "u/s" followed by the role:
 - *Fiddler on the Roof* (u/s Teveye)
- Other activities you participate in, at Cheltenham or elsewhere (e.g. Touring Ensemble, a cappella, sports, instruments you play, youth group, etc.)
- Thanks or shout-outs to family, friends, teachers, etc.
- If you are a senior and know what your plans are for next year, feel free to tell us where you'll be going to school and/or what you plan to study
